Spray Foam Insulation FAQ

Q. Do you offer spray foam insulation?

A. Yes.

Q. How long does the foam last?

A. Spray foam insulation offers lifetime protection.

Q. How does spray foam insulation work?

A. It fills and seals all voids, nooks, crannies and pockets, forming an air barrier around your home or building.

Q. Do mice or other rodents like it?

A. Spray foam insulation does not offer any usable food source or nesting materials to mice or other rodents.

Q. Is the foam safe for people with allergies?

A. Yes. In fact, it reduces airborne dust and fibres and creates a draft-free environment.

Q. Does the foam contain formaldehyde?

A. No, it is formaldehyde-free.

Q. Is spray foam insulation environmentally friendly?

A. Yes. It has no off-gassing, VOCs, or CFCs.

Q. Can you spray this foam on the ceiling and will it stick?

A. Yes, this foam will adhere to any clean, dry surface.

Q. Will using spray foam insulation save me money?

A. While the initial cost of installing spray foam insulation may be higher than traditional fiberglass, the money you save in utility bills year after year makes it a worthwhile choice in the long run. The foam usually will pay for itself in about 5 years.
